For most, it does not happen overnight. It is very much a degenerating process, a slippery slope to moral defeat. What are practical steps Christians can take to deal with temptation? - Pray to him faithfully (Matt 6:9-13; Jn 14:13-14; 1 Thess. 5:17; 1 Jn. 5:14-15
- Take your spiritual pulse regularly

- Entrapment into habitual sin (Proverbs 2:19; 5:22-23; 7:6-10; 23:27-28; cf. Rom. 6:19; Heb. 3:13)
- Venereal disease (Proverbs 5:7-11; cf. Psalm 38:1-8,11)
- Wounds inflicted by an angry spouse (Proverbs 6:33-35)
- Physical death (Proverbs 5:9; 6:32; cf. 1 Corinthians 5:5; 11:30; 1 John 5:16)
- Devastating spiritual effects (Proverbs 7:27: 6:32)
