Shaping a Message: From Text to Idea

How do we move from personal Bible study to preparing a message that is biblical, clear, engaging, and relevant to our listeners? 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I. The Four 'Locations' of sermon preparation

A. Location 1 - "The Study"

1. Passage Selection

- 2. Passage Study
- 3. Passage Purpose
- 4. Passage Idea

B. Location 2 - "The Prayer Place"

1. Pray through your own response to the passage

2. Pray for your listeners' response to the passage
