Grow – Planting (Multiplying)

A church-plant grows towards maturity as it develops a clear vision for planting again and is equipped and released to do just that. In thinking through church-multiplication: when is it the right time to multiply? What are the different models for church-planting for Europe today? What steps need to be taken to grow a church to multiply?
