
WAS EINSTEIN RIGHT?

Knowledge is limited. Imagination encircles the world.








INNOVATION

JOHANNES GUTENBERG was a German inventor and craftsman who introduced letterpress printing to Europe with his movable-type printing press.




Gravity Powered Toilet




FLUSH TOILET

Henry Ford was an American industrialist and business magnate.

A Latvian engineer and inventor who founded The Krastin Automobile Company in 1901, two years before Ford.







Orville & Wilbur Wright invented and flew the world's first successful airplane in 1903. Their persistence, experimentation, and work on the principles of flight made them legendary inventors and innovators.


MISSIONARY AVIATION

Sir Alexander Fleming was a Scottish biologist and pharmacologist, who discovered Penicillin.



THE INTERNET

The Internet started in the 1960s as a way for government researchers to share information. Today, millions of computers around the world are connected by cables, fibre, and wireless links.

as one of the great innovators.



Without **innovation** it is a corpse.


