As soon as you finish planning, something is going to change!





## Planning Organizational Chart





### Reminders on Planning

- 3-5 year horizon
- Strategic, forward-looking, purposeful
- It's messy there are other people involved 😊
- It does take time and ultimately saves time & energy
- Provides focus for relationships & resources
- It's living, ongoing, breathing, active
- It WILL change (Planning not Plan)






