Greg's letter to his closest friends:

My Confession in the Letter

"Each of us is very aware of our own brokenness and weakness. Each of you know me well, warts and all, as I in turn know you. This self-knowledge tends to immobilize us with self-doubts and selfaccusations: 'Who am I to say such a thing, to attempt anything?' Satan uses our knowledge of our sinfulness to accuse us and immobilize us for ministry.

"God is great and good and he can use men like Wilberforce (or us) who willfully give themselves to His service. Often, we slide from this positive vision to feel inadequate because we lack co-workers who will help and encourage us to fully live for and be used by God."

Wilberforce Biography

Wilberforce's biographer said ---

"Wilberforce was proof that a man may change his times, though he cannot do it alone."

Wilberforce and his co-workers' guiding principle was --"Find a neighbor, before you find a house."

- -- can accomplish what we want to accomplish


-- without brothers and sisters who will encourage us and live out the biblical "one anothers" with us: "Love one another," "Serve one another," "Help one another."


What Does a Gospel Leader Need?




The Forum is a community of Evangelical leaders with the same convictions and strategy (Forum Convictions) toward the same goal (Forum Impacts)











Ministry Partnerships

Ministry Partnerships: Develop purposeful ministry collaborations for Europe.

a) They develop kingdom-minded leaders who give part of their time and energy outside of their main ministry to others in the kingdom of God.

b) They partner with other Evangelical leaders to unite, equip, and resource Evangelical leaders in their nation and region.

c) They identify and distribute best practice strategies across their denomination and country and across Europe.

d) They join other leaders to extend and amplify the impact of local, national, and regional ministry efforts.

National Forum Movements

National and regional movements: To unite, equip, and resource evangelical leaders across Europe to reach their countries for Christ

a) Leaders with a burning passion to follow the example of the Apostle Paul in Europe by preaching the Gospel where it has never been preached.

b) Leaders who seek to unite, equip, and resource evangelical leaders in their local and national context toward the vision of communicating the Gospel and renewing the biblical church.

c) Evangelical leaders working across Evangelical denominational and organization lines at the local and national level.

d) Leaders who intentionally share resources and best practices with other churches, groups and movements.

e) Leaders who establish contextually specific strategies and initiatives based on the needs of their local and national context.
