Sex: It Really Is God's Idea

Sex in marriage was designed by a loving Creator to be a highly spiritual act of worship that declares the "the *echad* of God" — the oneness of the Triune God (Deuteronomy 6:4). This sessions explores the beauty of sexual union as it relates to covenantal, restorative and sacred oneness.
