Astrophysics Points to the God of the Bible

From the laws of physics themselves and their physical constants to the astrophysical picture of the development of the universe to the unique astronomical setting of our solar system, particularly the Sun, Earth, Earth's moon, and Jupiter, we find how exactly each element must be specified "just so" to allow for the existence and well-being of intelligent human life. The case will be made for just how precise the tuning had to be, and how many different things had to be specified "just so" at the same time. Actual probability estimates show how unlikely it is that the universe has its present form without a great Designer/Creator. Few people have a greater grasp of the physical arguments for intelligent design than Dr Hugh Ross. This lecture will also be given at the European Apologetics Network and as a workshop open to all Forum attendees.

Dr Hugh Ross had his curiosity captured by physics and astronomy by the age of seven. By age seventeen he was the youngest person ever to serve as director of observations for Vancouver's Royal Astronomical Society. He earned a BSc in physics from the University of British Columbia and the MSc and PhD in astronomy from the University of Toronto. For several years he continued his research on quasars and galaxies as a post-doctoral fellow at the California Institute of Technology. Over the years Dr Ross has given hundreds of lectures, seminars, and courses both in the United States and abroad, on Christian scientific apologetics. He founded and leads the organization "Reasons to Believe," and has authored or co-authored more than 10 books and many audio and video lecture tapes. He lives in southern California with his wife, Kathy, and sons, Joel and David.
