The High Price of My Anger

A burst of anger, a pout of bitterness, a mean-spirited remark — all very expensive. - 1. Emotionally (Prov. 30:33)
- 2. Socially (Prov. 17:1; 21:9)
- 3. Physically (cf. medical research)
- 4. Spiritually (Eph. 4:26-32; Gal. 5:20-23; Prov. 29:22)
 - Unresolved anger gives the Devil an open door into our lives
 - Unresolved anger does not extend grace to others
 - Unresolved anger grieves the Holy Spirit
 - Unresolved anger mocks the kindness and forgiveness we have received
