Multiplying the Church in Europe: See the Possibilities!

Imagine a movement of timed-release church planting, in which every church plants a new church every three years. In the space of just fifteen years we would see 32 churches planted but more importantly we would see multiplication extended into a fifth generation. This is the new now; the vision we want before us.

Dietrich Schindler (D.Min) is a German-American missionary church planter who is currently the Europe-wide Church Planting consultant for the Evangelical Free Church of Germany (Bund Freier evangelischer Gemeinden). Under his leadership the denomination is striving to plant 100 new churches in Germany in ten years. After seven years 65 churches have been planted. He has himself planted five churches in Germany and has written and lectured on what it would take to see a church planting multiplication movement to take root in Germany and in Europe. He is the author of *The Jesus Model: Planting Churches like Jesus*. Dietrich has been married to Jan Carla for thirty-two years, and they have three adult children. He has also generated a new life-based course for secular post-modern Europeans entitled "MyLife-Workshop" (www.mylifeworkshop.org)
