Stick to Your Calling: How God's Call Gives Long-Term Direction to Your Church Plant

European experience shows that planting a healthy church takes four to seven years, sometimes more. In this session we will see how God's call to the Church Planter and the core team will give long time direction and endurance to faithfully finish the task. One part of responding to the call is determining and living out shared core values. How this can be done will also be covered in this session.

Richard Hultmar is a church planter from Luleå, Sweden. He is an ordained pastor with InterAct. After leading evangelism and church planting teams for the organization "Team i Norr" to the Murmansk Region of Russia in the 1990s, he moved to Luleå and started Korskyrkan 2001, a church he is still pastoring. Between 2007 and 2009 he oversaw church planting for InterAct Sweden. Since 2007 Richard has led the Swedish Church Planting Network, a network joining many evangelical denominations in Sweden in order to see new churches planted across the country. Richard is now working to establish the M4 church planting training program in Sweden. He also coaches church planters in the north of Sweden and is working in partnership with local churches and missionaries to plant house churches on the campus of Luleå Technical University.
