Kingdom Collaboration

There are many resources to help churches improve their impact and effectiveness in how they work as a church. But, when the church ventures beyond its walls to work with other entities, be they other churches, other ministries or within the community, the path to success is much less clear. This workshop will teach participants some of the principles and keys to creating successful collaborations.
