Clear Vision – Clear Results: Understanding the Power of Vision in Church Planting

A clear vision is best communicated by those who have a heartfelt passion to see the vision be fulfilled. In this session we will look at the specifics of discovering and formulating a vision, and how to communicate it in such a way that it helps steer the church plant through growth, conflict, potential mission drift and other threats to the life of the church plant.
