
Is the Injeel Corrupted? How to Share the Validity of the New Testament with Muslims

Injeel is the Arabic word for New Testament. The Quran asserts that Jesus was sent from God and was given the Injeel. However, millions of Muslims are taught that the Injeel is corrupted!
