The integrity of the upright guides them, but the perversity of the treacherous destroys them.




## PRAISEWORTHY

#### **2 TIMOTHY 3:10**

But you have followed my teaching, conduct, purpose, faith, patience, love, and endurance . . .



#### **JAMES 1:22-25**

<sup>22</sup> But be doers of the word and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. 23 Because if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like someone looking at his own face in a mirror. <sup>24</sup> For he looks at himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of person he was. <sup>25</sup> But the one who looks intently into the perfect law of freedom and perseveres in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer who works—this person will be blessed in what he does.
