



Europe, as the primary source of global Unbelief, is uniquely strategic for the Gospel.




European Evangelical leaders are isolated in a secular, post-Christian context.

- Lack of Hope and Vision




In an age of Unbelief, apologetics, or persuasively communicating the Gospel, is crucial.



- Paul was a persuasive evangelist (which is what "apologist" means) and was at home in any venue because he sought to explain why the Gospel was true.
- Apologetics are necessary to help believers understand what they believe and why they believe it – to help them live out their faith with confidence and courage.

The biblical worldview must be the framework for all teaching and leadership.
