FOCL Talk 2: How Should Christians Respond to the Transgender Agenda?

With the prominence of the transgender issue, Christians cannot ignore it. How is the transgender agenda impacting the church and what opportunities and threats does it bring? How do we respond to the ideology and those involved both biblically and pastorally?
