The Dynamics of Discipleship

In this session we'll look at the "how" of disciple-making. We will go through the ins and outs of how to start and guide a discipleship meeting. We'll look at the strengths of one-on-one meetings, small groups, and large classes. We'll also cover issues of duration, frequency, and setting the tone for each meeting. Time will be reserved for asking questions about how discipleship could look in your own context.
