
Step One—Create a Picture of the Ideal

- ☐ Regardless of what you intend to do (plan), the process begins by creating a vision for what you want to accomplish.
- ☐ Respond to the question, if this project, program, special activity, and/or event were to be 100% successful, what would the result look like? Imagine.
- ☐ Dream. Engage the input of others.
- ☐ Share your vision with others.



Step Two--Assessment

- ☐ Take a long look at what you have done in the past
- ☐ On a scale from 1-10, how does your reality compare to your ideal (profile)?



Step Three--Quantify

Begin to make a list of deficiencies



Step Four—Prioritize

Of all the deficiencies you listed in Step 3, prioritize the issues in terms of their importance



Step 5--Plan

- ☐ Plan everything!
- ☐ Start with small projects
- ☐ Long-term strategic planning needs to occur in smaller increments. It's hard to keep up with technology.
- ☐ Every plan is critical, regardless of its size. Plan everything!

- ☐ Begin pulling together teams to support each of your planning initiatives.
