The Problem > Britain: 25% no close friends

 \rightarrow US: Quadrupled since 1990

EU: 10% Italians no friends

> EU: 12-40% frequently lonely

"A friend is some I can talk to, depend on, grow with, and enjoy"








The Circles of Friendship

30% lack close friendships








Q: What forces make friendship difficult for Christian leaders?

The Solution

Recognise friendship as a sacred calling

> Father rescues from idolatry (Ps 103:1-5)

Jesus rescues from insularity (Gal 3:23)

Holy Spirit rescues from implosion (Gal 5:22-26)


