


Secular Equality!

Christianity vs secularism

Christianity: Image of God

- Every individual is of infinite value
- Every individual must be treated with dignity and justice
- Worth is not connected to activity

Secular egalitarianism

- Vague notion of equality applied in select and mechanical socially constructed ways
- Worth is connected to work and societal contribution

- The objection to 'sexism' is too narrow

Broad objections

- The Creator is not allowed to differentiate the roles, vocations or favours given to his creatures unless there is something about the creatures which requires it.
- The Creator is obliged to treat creatures of the same type equally.
- If the Creator differentiates without cause, he must be bad / nasty / unloving.

A differentiating God

- The claim that God is a being who treats his creatures differentially is a repeated core claim of the Bible.
- Therefore objecting to the Bible on the ground that God differentiates is simply a repetition of a value from another religion (e.g. secular atheism), not a forceful argument.
- It is also a central claim of the biblical text that God grants more favour than we deserve.
- God's people are depicted as a female for whom God's Son gives himself.
